BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the City Council approves funding, as specified below, for a variety of programs in the Holly Street Neighborhood, including recreational and educational opportunities for children and neighborhood improvements in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000, and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute such contracts with each recipient entity as are reasonable, necessary or required to accomplish the purposes of this funding; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Holly Good Neighbor Program funds for FY 2009-2010 be allocated as follows:

- \$550,000 to the Neighborhood Housing and Community Development for the Holly Neighborhood Home Rehabilitation Program,
- \$125,000 for the Holly Neighborhood Grants Assistance Program managed by Austin Energy,
- \$125,000 for cultural arts projects,
- \$100,000 to the Austin Police Department to maintain a walking beat in the Holly Neighborhood,

- \$50,000 for after-school programs,
- \$50,000 for CIP projects; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the City Council allocates \$10,000 from the FY 2009-2010 Cultural Arts Projects funds to facilitate the creation of a youth-focused sociocultural program in schools in and around the Holly neighborhood, associated with the publication of "Austin East of I-35," a photo documentary book by Rama Tiru.
