**Subject:** Authorize negotiation and execution of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Travis County, Texas, Austin Independent School District and Texas Health and Human Services Commission on behalf of the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services for reimbursement to the City of Austin for the initial and on-going costs of security systems and services, furniture and equipment, signage and other fixtures and equipment installed at the Austin Ridge Campus, 8509 FM 969, Building 690, Austin, Texas for the co-located leased space in connection with the Austin/Travis County Child Protection Team.

Amount and Source of Funding: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact.

The lease agreement was approved by Council on May 21, 2009 and is for 60 months; with two 60 month extention options (for a total lease term of 15 years). The construction has moved forward and the involved parties are scheduled to occupy the Austin Ridge Campus during March of 2010.

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the following parties: The City of Austin, Travis County, the Austin Independent School District (AISD), and the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (State).

All parties have leased adjoining space at the Austin Ridge Campus, 8509 FM 969, Building 690, Austin, Texas, to be used as office space by the Austin Police Department, the Travis County Sheriff's Office, the Travis County District Attorney, AISD and the State.

The City of Austin either directly or through contracted vendors, will be providing access control system equipment and services, main lobby furniture, equipment and furnishings, and building room signage (the "Co-location Equipment and Services") for the offices occupied by the parties at the Austin Ridge Campus.

The involved parties agree that it would be mutually advantageous for them to share the Co-location Equipment and Services in their respective offices at Austin Ridge Campus. The parties have requested that the City of Austin provide the Co-location Equipment and services to the Austin Ridge Campus. The City of Austin is also willing to provide the system, either directly or through its contracted vendors, under the terms and conditions described in the interlocal agreement which will provide on-going reimbursement for costs associated with these items over the term of the lease.
