

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution 20080508-050 directing the City Manager to identify areas within the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 budget to conduct facilitated community discussions of the Hispanic/Latino quality of life issues in Austin; develop strategies to address the findings coming out of a Community Scorecard and the discussions; and report back to Council with recommendations incorporating key strategies in the City's overall economic development program; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Resolution 20080508-050, City Staff formed a Core Team and hired a consultant to conduct facilitated community discussions and provide data resulting from those discussions; and

WHEREAS, 4 community-wide forums were held in Spring 2009 throughout the City of Austin addressing: Education, Economic Development/Housing, Cultural Arts/History/Enrichment and Healthcare; and

WHEREAS, City Staff provided a briefing and recommendations to Council for further action on August 27, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the next step identified was to create a Community Oversight Team to review the consultant's report and provide feedback to the City Staff Core Team so that final recommendations and an action plan can be presented to City Council; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
