Item #57 on the May 27, 2010 Council Agenda, to approve the waiver of certain fees and requirements and authorize payment of certain costs for the City co-sponsored Greater East Austin Youth Association's 2010 Juneteenth Parade and Celebration which is to be held on June 19, 2010, at Rosewood Park, will have the following fiscal impact:

Fees Waived:

- \$2,000 Street Sweeping (Solid Waste Services)
- \$649.42 Dumpster Services (Solid Waste Services)
- \$23,600 Austin Police Department Costs (APD)
- \$3,300 Emergency Medical Services Costs (EMS)
- \$250 Application Fee (Austin Transportation)
- \$76 Safety Inspection Fee (Austin Transportation)
- \$33 Sound Permit Fee (Austin Transportation)
- \$7,200 Barricade Use Fees (Austin Transportation)
- \$1,500 Traffic Safety Plan (Austin Transportation)
- \$1,500 Permit Fee (Austin Transportation)

\$1,100 Permit and Banner Installation (Planning and Development Review)

\$41,208.42 Total Fees Waived

In summary, the total fee waivers being waived for this event are \$41,208.42. Additionally, the security deposit requirement of \$2,000 is also being waived. Any fee requirements above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

This is one of the city co-sponsored special events per Resolution No. 021003-40.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
