That the City Attorney, or other authorized designee, is hereby authorized and directed to file, or cause to be filed, a suit in eminent domain on behalf of the City of Austin against the owners now having, or who may acquire, an interest in the real property interest needed by the City, described below, for the public purposes set out below, and to take whatever other action may be deemed appropriate to effect the needed acquisitions.

Project: Fort Branch WMA Reach 6 & 7 - Truelight Area and

Eleanor Drive Area

Public Purpose: the permanent drainage easement described in the

attached Exhibit "A" is necessary to stabilize the Fort Branch Creek bank, protect it from erosion, and to increase the size of the creek to reduce the frequency and depth of flooding in the surrounding

neighborhood.
