Subject: Conduct a public hearing and consider an ordinance amending City Code related to the processing of applications for historic landmark designation.

Boards and Commission Action: Recommended by Historic Landmark Commission, Zoning and Platting Commission, and Planning Commission.

Prior Council Action: June 10, 2010 - Council directed the City Manager to process a code amendment limiting the number of owner-initiated and Historic Landmark Commission initiated cases per month. August 5, 2010 - Council postponed to August 19, 2010.

On June 10, 2010, the Council approved a resolution (20100610-029) directing the City Manager to process an amendment to the City Code limiting the number of owner-initiated and Historic Landmark Commission initiated historic landmark applications to three per month except in the case of nominations initiated by the Commission in response to a request for a demolition or relocation permit; and to generally limit the number of owner-initiated and Historic Landmark Commission-initiated nominations in a National Register or Local Historic Districts to one per month except in the case of nominations initiated by the Commission in response to a request for a demolition or relocation permit.
