

ORDINANCE NO. 80 0703-I

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 800508-M (THE RAINEY STREET MORATORIUM ORDINANCE); PROVIDING THAT THE MORATORIUM SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT FOR WHICH AN APPLICATION HAS BEEN FILED WITH THE BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE MORATORIUM; SUSPENDING THE RULE REQUIRING THE READING OF ORDINANCES ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. That Ordinance No. 800508-M (The Rainey Street Moratorium Ordinance), be, and it is hereby, amended by allowing the issuance of a building permit for which an application has been filed with the Building Inspection Department prior to the date of the moratorium effective date of May 8, 1980.

PART 2. WHEREAS, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public, which emergency requires the suspension of the rule providing for the reading of an ordinance on three separate days, and requires that this ordinance become effective immediately upon its passage; therefore, the rule requiring the reading on three separate days is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage; therefore, the rule requiring the reading on three separate days is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage as provided by the Charter of the City of Austin.
