Subject

Approve an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Economic Development Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20150908-001) to adopt a budget for the Austin Downtown Public Improvement District, with a beginning balance of \$304,647, revenue of \$5,174,560, and requirements of \$5,182,888.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding is available through a beginning balance of \$304,647; \$5,039,353 in 2016 assessments (at a 96% collection rate), \$32,228 in collections from 2015; \$17,435 interest accrued in the PID Account and late payments; and \$150,000 annual contribution from the City (\$75,000 Austin Convention Center Fund, and \$75,000 in the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund).

Additional Backup Information

This action amends the Economic Development Department Special Revenue Fund for the Austin Downtown Public Improvement District (PID) to account for 2016 assessment collections and contributions, and to appropriate a budget for service delivery.

Total projected revenue is \$5,039,353 in 2016 assessments (at a 96% collection rate), \$32,228 in collections from 2015; \$17,435 interest accrued in the PID Account and late payments; and \$150,000 annual contribution from the City (\$75,000 Austin Convention Center Fund, and \$75,000 in the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund). The appropriation of \$5,039,353 is for a contract with the Downtown Austin Alliance to coordinate and subcontract for service enhancements in the PID, including security, maintenance, graffiti removal, litter control, education, economic development and marketing.
