<p>On September 10, 2015, during the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget, City Council passed and approved Ordinance No. 20150908-006 establishing the civil service classifications for the Emergency Medical Services Department, authorizing 518 sworn positions. The department wishes to amend the ordinance to eliminate three (3) Medic II Communications positions and create three (3) Medic I Communications positions for the purposes of hiring entry level Medic I Communications positions due to staffing needs in the Communications Division. This action does not change the total number of classified positions in the Communications Division or in the Department.</p> <p>This ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 20150908-006.
