## Subject

Authorize the negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 2 for a 12-month extension of an interlocal agreement with AUSTIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT for parent support specialist services in an amount not to exceed \$684,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,934,000.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$684,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Operating Budget of the Health and Human Services Department. The Agreement extension term is January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

## Additional Backup Information

The previous AISD interlocal agreement (ILA) included a 14-month term from November 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015 as the result of funding earmarked by Council in the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 budget. Amendment No. 1 of the ILA did not affect the budget or purpose of the ILA. Amendment No. 2 of the ILA extends the term for an additional 12 months from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016 in an amount not to exceed \$684,000. The additional one-time funding is an earmarked amount in the Operating Budget approved for Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

Parent Support Specialist Services programming provides educational and skill-building services to parents and families of AISD students. Services provided include parent-education programming, building parent-life skills, the development of parent leaders, and referrals of parents and families to other social services regarding mental and behavioral health.
