

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, Council approved Resolution No. 20150305-025 on March 5, 2015, which created the Parkland Events Task Force (PETF). The PETF was created to develop recommendations to ensure that all City parks, most particularly Auditorium Shores, Zilker Park, and Festival Beach, remain first and foremost assets for the citizens of Austin to enjoy and that the parks are preserved and enhanced for future generations of Austinites and visitors to experience and enjoy and

WHEREAS, the PETF was set to expire upon the completion of its assigned tasks or one year after the effective date of Resolution No. 20150305-025 and to provide a final draft report to the Council Committee on Open Space, Environment, and Sustainability no later than June 5, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to extend the PETF's expiration date and report due date; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Resolution No. 20150305-025 is amended to state that the due date for PETF's final report is August 31, 2016; and that the report be presented to the Council Committee on Open Space, Environment, and Sustainability on September 28, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

Resolution No. 20150305-025 is amended to state that the PETF shall expire upon the completion of its assigned tasks or September 28, 2016, whichever is sooner.
