Additional Backup Information

In order to modify or alter the existing speed limit of a street, the Texas laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. An investigation of East Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard was conducted by the Traffic Engineering Division of the Austin Transportation Department in accordance with the procedures specified in the Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, 2006. As a result of this investigation, the Traffic Engineering Division recommends adding the following amendments to the City Code Section 12-4-64(D) (Table of Speed Limits):

Delete: Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (East) from Airport Boulevard to J.J. Seabrook Drive. (35 MPH)

Amend: Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (East) from I.H. 35 (North) East Frontage Road to Tillery Street [Airport Boulevard]. (35 MPH)

Add: Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (East) from Tillery Street to J.J. Seabrook Drive (45 MPH)
