## Additional Backup Information

In order to modify or alter the existing speed limit of a street, the Texas Traffic Laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. Traffic volumes, traffic speeds, and pedestrian volumes and patterns were evaluated on this section of Vargas Road by the Austin Transportation Department to determine if modifications were appropriate to improve the safety for the students attending Allison Elementary School. Based on this investigation, the Austin Transportation Department recommends adding the following amendment to the City Code Section 12-4-64(D) (Table of Speed Limits):

**Amend:** Vargas Road from 30 feet north of the north curbline of Ponca Street to <u>140</u> [280] feet north of the north curbline of Lynch Lane (Allison Elementary School). (20 MPH School Zone)
