

M/WBE Summary

Participation subgoals stated in the solicitation were 1.90% African American; 9.00% Hispanic; 4.90% Native/Asian; 15.80% WBE. The recommended firm provided a MBE/WBE Compliance Plan that met the goals of the solicitation and was approved by the Small and Minority Business Resources Department. The second ranked firm provided a MBE/WBE Compliance Plan that met the goals of the solicitation and was approved by the Small and Minority Business Resources Department.

Notification of issuance of a Request for Qualifications was issued on March 7, 2016 through the City's Vendor Connection web portal which resulted in 2005 firms receiving notice. The solicitation was obtained by 48 firms and two submitted qualifications statements. None of the firms submitting were certified MBE/WBE.
