

RESOLUTION NO. 20160518-001

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2016, a special municipal election was held as a result of a valid initiative petition, to present to the voters a proposed ordinance for which voters were given the option of voting “for the ordinance” or “against the ordinance;” and

WHEREAS, the returns of the special election have been made to the Council and show that the votes for and against the proposition were cast as follows:

Proposition No. 1

For 39,109

Against 49,208

WHEREAS, a majority of all votes cast in the special election were cast against Proposition No. 1; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:


The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the special election as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the election; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special election, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that the proposed ordinance the subject of Proposition No. 1 is not adopted.

With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from the counties.
