The purpose of this Advance Funding Agreement is to accept funds to construct the Upper Boggy Creek Trail from East 12 Street to the MLK Jr. Metrorail station. The project has been designed and engineered using bond funding, primarily from the 2000 and 2012 general obligation bonds.

This project will connect neighborhoods, parks and schools directly to the Metrorail station, providing bicycle and pedestrian accommodation for users of all abilities and contribute to the creation of a multi-modal connection for users of the Capital Metro transit system. This project is also part of the overarching vision for the Eastlink Trail, which strives to connect popular destinations on the east side of Austin from Bartholomew Pool and park to Lady Bird Lake and Butler park trail.

Project design and construction is managed by the Public Works Department.
