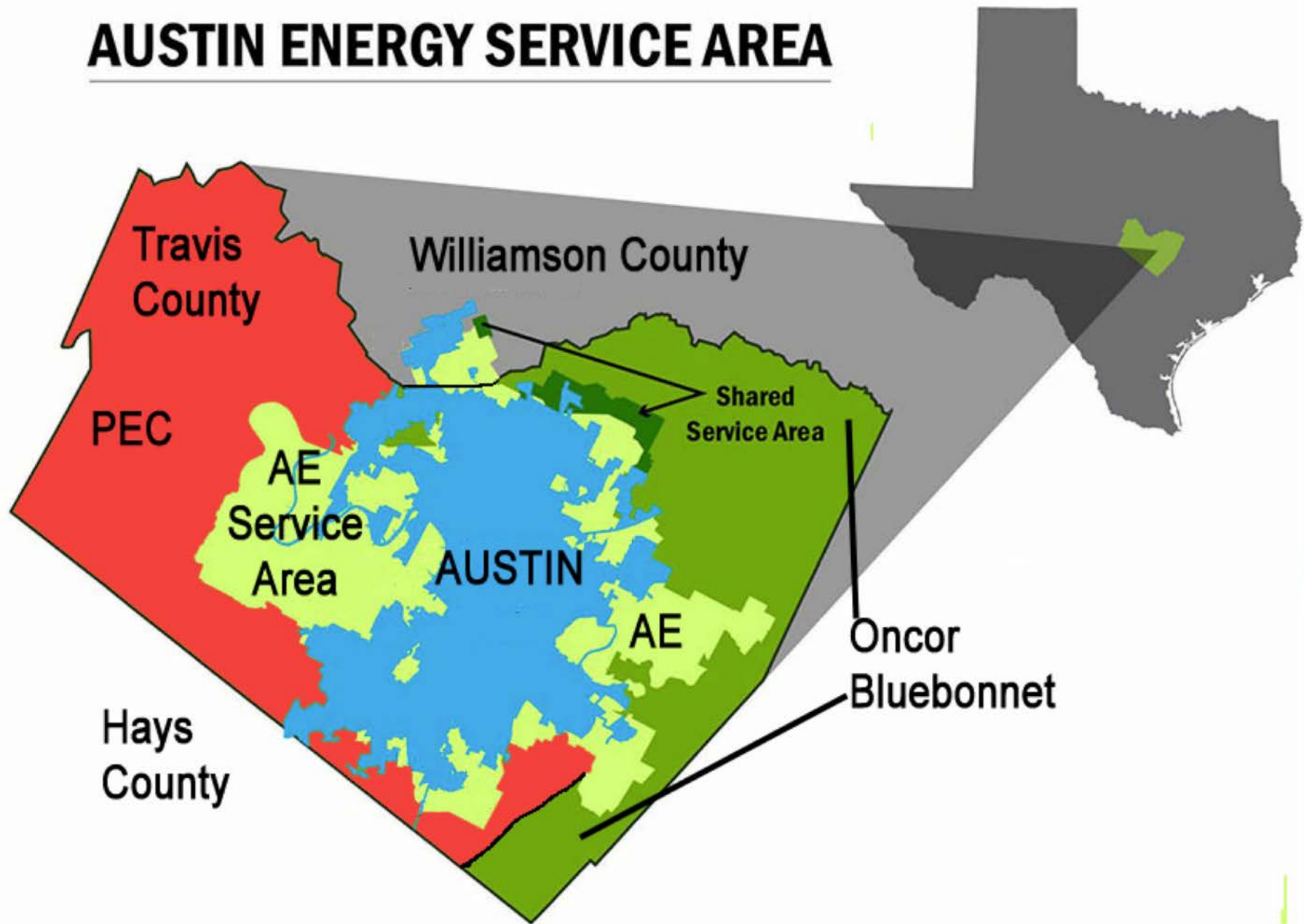

# **FY 2016 Electric Service Delivery Budget: \$82.1 Mil**

AE Customers Outside City Limits: **14%**

Out-of-City Cost Based on Customers: **\$11.5 Mil**

AE Service Area Outside City Limits: **53%**

Out-of-City Cost Based Service Area: **\$43.5 Mil**

**\$450 Million in T&D CIP in 5 Years**

Pedernales Elec Coop	\$20 or 6%	No
San Marcos	10%	No
San Antonio CPS	2% ex. fuel, sales tax	No
