On June 23, 2016, the City Council passed Resolution No. 2016o623-082 initiating a code amendment to "require that any application for a demolition permit of a building fifty years or older and dedicated to civic uses...have a hearing before the Historic Landmark Commission."

The proposed amendment would require Historic Landmark Commission review for structures fifty years or older that are dedicated to certain civic uses.
