Additional Backup Information

On September 22, 2016, by Resolution No. 20160922-020, City Council approved the creation of the Austin/Travis County Sobriety Center Local Government Corporation (LGC), approved and adopted the Articles of Incorporation for the LGC, approved its bylaws, and appointed the initial directors of the board. The resolution also authorized and directed the City Manager and all other City officials and employees to perform all such acts as may be necessary or desirable in order to carry out the terms and provisions of the resolution, including filing the Articles of Incorporation for the LGC. On November 2, 2016, the Texas Secretary of State filed the certificate of formation and issued the certificate of filing evidencing the existence of the newly created non-profit LGC.

The proposed interlocal between the City and the LGC will enable the LGC to perform a series of initial actions necessary to establish a sobriety center, including but not limited to the possible hiring of recruiting firm to assist in recruiting an executive director. The LCG will also have the ability to hire administrative support personnel, accounting services, and legal counsel.
