ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This item allows the Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) to accept up to \$250,000 from the Trail of Lights Foundation to fund projected expenditures. The total estimated expenditures for this event are anticipated to be approximately \$165,000. All expenses incurred are regularly reimbursed by the organizer. Upon conclusion of the event, PARD will review actual department expenditures to ensure the costs are fully recovered.

Additionally, the total fee waivers of approximately \$158,557 and the PARD refundable deposit requirements of \$3,500 are a part of the co-sponsorship agreement and for related permits, park use and street closure fees.
