## **Budget**

Approve a resolution declaring the City of Austin's official intent to reimburse itself from Contractual Obligations in the amount of \$1,600,000 for the Austin Resource Recovery vehicles and equipment, and \$165,000 for vehicles and equipment for other City departments.

## **Additional Backup Information:**

A citymusthavebudgetedforandprovidedasourceoffundsinordertoenter intoacontract. For the City to spendmoneytoday, but reimburse itself from the issuance of debtobligations in the future, state and federal law require the City to approve a reimbursement resolution. The resolution must contain certain information to protect the tax exempt status of the future issuance. Failure to adopt a qualified declaration of official intent will prohibit the City from reimbursing the cost with the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations. Reimbursement bonds generally must be issued no later than 18 months after the later of, the date the expenditure was made, or the date that the project with respect to which the expenditure was made, is placed inservice.

This action expresses the City Council's intent to authorize the reimbursement of costs associated with Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Approved Capital Budget items for General Obligation debt, as described below:

General Obligation Contractual Obligations: \$1,765,000

- \$1,600,000 for Austin Resource Recovery vehicles and equipment;
- $\cdot$  \$165,000 for vehicles and equipment for other City departments.
