ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This amends the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Police Federal Department of Justice Asset Forfeiture Fund Budget to allow for unanticipated savings from FY 2016-2017 to be appropriated for the construction contract for the Public Safety Training Academy Tenant Finish Out Building I project. The Austin Police Department did not spend \$696,710 that was estimated to be spent in the FY2016-2017 budget year. This spending was delayed due to a capita project bid exceeding APD's original funding estimates. Due to the amount of the bid (\$1,523,500), the Department requestec a written approval from the Department of Justice to use the funds in this account for the capital project, which also delayed
