38 **PART 3.** City Code Section 13-2-103 Subsection (B) (*Disqualification for Certain*
39 *Offenses*) is amended to read:

- 40 (1) a felony not listed in subsection (B) of this section;
- 41 (2) the misdemeanor sale, manufacture, or delivery of a controlled
42 substance or chemical precursor;
- 43 (3) driving, flying, or boating while intoxicated or under the influence;
- 44 (4) prostitution;
- 45 (5) fraud;
- 46 (6) resisting or evading arrest or detention;
- 47 (7) reckless driving or obstructing a highway or other passageway;
- 48 (8) felony conviction for possession, [~~the~~] sale, manufacture, or delivery
49 of a controlled substance or chemical precursor;
- 50 (9) use of a motor vehicle to commit a felony;
- 51 (10) criminal offenses involving the use of a deadly weapon;
- 52 (11) felonies involving acts of violence;
- 53 (12) felonies involving acts of terror;
- 54 (13) multiple felony offenses; [ø]
- 55 (14) promotion of prostitution, aggravated promotion of prostitution, or
56 compelling prostitution;
- 57 (15) felony conviction for driving while intoxicated; or

59 **PART 4.** City Code Chapter 13-2 (*Ground Transportation Passenger Services*)
60 Section 13-2-121 (*Exception from Chauffeur's Permit Requirement*) is repealed.

61 **PART 5.** Subsections (B) and (D) of City Code Section 13-2-202 (*Limousine Service*
62 *Requirements*) are repealed, and Subsection C is renumbered and repealed and replaced
63 to read as follows:

64 (B)[(C)] A holder may provide limousine service using a full-sized sedan
65 vehicle categorized as a luxury vehicle within the automobile industry, with a minimum
66 occupancy capacity of four passengers excluding the driver, or a vehicle categorized by
67 the automobile industry as a sport utility vehicle with a minimum occupancy capacity of
68 four passengers excluding the driver, or a sport activity vehicle with a minimum
69 occupancy capacity of four passengers excluding the driver.

70 **PART 6.** City Code Section 13-2-203 (*Limousine Minimum Rate of Fare*) is repealed
71 and City Code Section 13-2-204 (*Trip Ticket Required*) is renumbered as Section 13-2-
72 203.

73 **PART 7.** City Code Section 13-2-267 (*Vehicle to Display Permit*) is repealed and the
74 subsequent sections are renumbered accordingly.

75 **PART 8.** City Code Section 13-2-286 (*Special Event Permit Application*) Subsection
76 (D) is repealed and Subsections (E) through (G) are relettered accordingly.

77 **PART 9.** City Code Section 13-2-291 (*Charter Van Service Requirements*) Subsection
78 (B) is amended to read:

79 A holder must:

80 (1) use vans, minibuses, buses, or motor coaches that comply with the
81 following requirements to provide charter van service:

82 (a) have an occupancy capacity of fifteen persons or less, including
83 the driver;

84 (b) have no top light or other electric identification sign;

85 (c) not use a taximeter;

86 (d) no checkered logo/pattern or insignia to represent the vehicle as a
87 taxicab;

88 (e) if a charter van service holder identifies its vehicles with outer
89 logos or other identification markings, all vehicles used to provide

90 charter services owned by the same holder shall have identical
91 markings on all vehicles that are unique to that holder.

92 (2) provide the department with a current list of drivers licensed in the
93 manner described in [Section 13-2-121](#) (*Exemption from Chauffeur's Permit*
94 *Requirement*), the driver's license number of each driver, and a photocopy
95 of each driver's license.

96 (3) provide the department with a copy of proof of a passing annual vehicle
97 inspection conducted by the City or the designated inspector authorized by
98 the City to conduct inspections.

99 (4) not hold itself out as a taxi service as defined in [Section 13-2-401](#) (*Taxi*
100 *Service Described*) [~~and cannot accept passengers less than one-half hour~~
101 ~~in advance of commencement of scheduled service]~~.

102 (5) A driver operating a charter van service vehicle shall keep in the vehicle,
103 in written or electronic form, a trip ticket containing the information
104 described below, and shall allow a person designated under [Section 13-2-](#)
105 [13\(B\)](#) (*Enforcement*) or [Section 13-2-14](#) (*Enforcement Officers*) to inspect
106 the trip ticket upon request. A trip ticket must include the following
107 information:

108 (a) date of the trip, the name, address, and phone number of the person
109 or group who booked or paid for the service;

110 (b) the name, address, and phone number of at least one passenger
111 transported on the trip;

112 (c) the pickup location, intermittent stops and the drop off location for
113 the trip;

114 (d) the date and time the reservation was made, and the scheduled and
115 actual passenger pick-up time;

116 (e) state the rate for services, if charged on an hourly rate, and total
117 amount of fare paid for each passenger or group of passengers using
118 the service; and

119 (f) identify the owner of the vehicle used to provide charter service
120 and identify the holder, if different, by name, address and telephone
121 number.
