

M/WBE Summary

Public notice was given for this solicitation CLMC658, 2016 Bond – ATD Bolt Down Device IDIQ, through the City's Vendor Connection web portal, which resulted in 156 contractors receiving notification and 28 contractors obtaining the bid documents. One bid was received and opened on September 21, 2017. The one bid received was not an MBE/WBE certified firm. DeNucci Constructors, LLC submitted the only responsive bid received:

DeNucci Constructors, LLC, Austin, Texas: \$1,145,640

The contractor did not identify the use of subcontractors for any of the five scopes of work identified for the project: delineators, striping streets, parking facilities, land division, pavement marking lines, letters and symbols; maintenance and repair, streets (Major and Residential); and pavement marking services, including removal.

Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 0.88% African American; 6.36% Hispanic; 0.43% Native/Asian, 0.49% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$1,145,640:
