The Austin Rosewood Community Development Corporation (ARCDC) is a local government corporation created to aid, assist, and act on behalf of the City of Austin in the performance of

essential governmental functions related to the operation of the Millennium Youth Entertainment Complex located at 1156 Hargrave St. The ARCDC is led by a Board of Directors made up of nine members appointed by council. The terms of these directors' positions have expired, and council is asked to appoint nine members to the board so that it may conduct business under its articles of incorporation and its bylaws.
