## Transportation - Mobility Bond

Authorize award and execution of a construction contract with DeNucci Constructors, LLC for the 2016 Bond - ATD Bolt Down Device Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity project in the amount of \$450,000 for an initial two-year term, with two one-year extension options of \$200,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$850,000. (Note: This contract will be awarded in compliance with City Code Chapter 2-9A [Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program] through the achievement of Good Faith Efforts.)

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### **Additional Backup Information:**

This item is a 2016 Mobility Bond Item. The City of Austin has established performance measures regarding the installation of various traffic control devices throughout the city limits. As the demand for traffic control devices continues to expand, the city is seeking methods to meet these increasing demands and provide services that support the established performance measures. This contract with DeNucci Constructors, LLC will allow the City of Austin to install various traffic control devices, via the contractor, including flexible delineator posts, raised pavement markers, bicycle racks, bicycle corrals, pavement markings, and speed cushions on Austin's roadways. This Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity contract will be used to support the Local Area Traffic Management Program as well as the Active Transportation Division of the Austin Transportation Department.

Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity contracts provide for an indefinite quantity of services for a fixed time, usually an initial term with extension options. They are commonly used when precise quantities of supplies or services, above a specified minimum, cannot be determined. Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity contracts help streamline the contract process and service delivery and allow the City the flexibility to add work as needs arise or change. As each project is defined, a specific work assignment will be given to the contractor who will complete the scope of work for the unit prices included in the contract. Work deadlines will be established for each work assignment.

The base bid was used to identify and determine the lowest responsive bidder and to determine contract unit prices for each bid item and the lowest bidder. The Capital Contracting Office received only one bid of the two Primes who attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting. The Prime that chose not to bid was unable to secure a sub-contractor in time for bid submittal. A Third company was interested in bidding, however they were not able to attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting.

This request allows for the award and execution of a construction contract with DeNucci

Constructors, LLC for an estimated period of two years with two one -year extensions. However if funds for the initial term are expended staff may accelerate the extension options, but in no event will exceed the total contract amount. The extension options are subject to the agreement of both parties.

This project may be located anywhere within the Austin city limits and performed in all City Council Districts.

DeNucci Constructors, LLC is located in Austin, Texas.
