# Residential Capacity Based Solar Incentive

- Since 2004, Residential Solar Incentive Program has spurred the development of 30 MW of installations at over 6,300 homes.
- 2014: capacity-based ramp down was initiated.
- Capacity-based residential incentive is currently in the final phase (\$0.40/W), and has 1.5 MW of capacity remaining.

- To be replaced by new residential Solar Education Program and more equitable solar incentive.
