Additional Backup Information:

In October, 2015, the City of Dripping Springs applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to discharge treated wastewater effluent into a tributary of Onion Creek, which will flow into the main stem of Onion Creek. In the fall of 2016, TCEQ issued a draft permit to the City of Dripping Springs that would allow a maximum capacity of 995,000 gallons per day.
