Additional Backup Information:

This budget amendment is part of the overall updated Project and Financing Plan for the Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone (TIRZ) No. 17, which allows for the issuance of a maximum of \$110 million to finance additional projects in the TIRZ. This public funding will be matched by \$203 million in private contributions. This is the first appropriation of the \$110 million.

Waterloo Park Link

The largest of the Chain of the Parks, Waterloo Park will be a gathering space for the City of Austin, including: a civic lawn, a performing arts venue, food service in the park, unique hill country gardens, wetlands, and extensive nature-based play areas. Within this link, a connection to Symphony Square and restoration of the creek and adjacent open space will be completed. Collectively, the space will be programmed with complementary activities furthering the mission to promote engaging art and

educational activities. \$25,000,000 will pay for design and construction phase services in Waterloo Park.
