

At this time, this analysis can not be performed. The Travis County Sheriff's Office recommends the "mental health / psych code" should only be reported by individuals with a "PSY" code. The nuances of the various codes are based or additional screening and are for internal reference and flagging. Additionally, these codes and their meanings have changed over time, but "PSY" has remained the initial screening flag and is the most appropriate code for these discrussions.
