Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 8 to an agreement with Foundation Communities, Inc. for the provision of permanent supportive housing services, adding one 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2018 in an amount not to exceed \$111,149, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$736,736.

Fiscal Note	Funding for the contract is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.
Prior Council Action	On August 17, 2017, Council approved Amendment 6 which added one 12-month extension option and \$108,438, on an 11-0 vote. On September 22, 2016, Council approved Amendment No. 4, which added one 12-month extension option and \$106,000, on an 8-1 vote with Council Member Zimmerman voting no, Council Member Casar off the dais, and Council Member Troxclair absent. On September 27, 2012, Council approved a 24-month agreement for \$200,000 beginning on September 27, 2012 with one 24-month extension option, on a 7-0 vote.

Approval of this item will authorize Austin Public Health to negotiate and execute Amendment No. 8 with Foundation Communities, allowing continuation of permanent supportive housing (PSH) services to individuals who have experienced chronic homelessness and frequent use of emergency systems and criminal justice systems. Councilauthorizationisbeingsoughtpriortotheadoption of the FiscalYear2018-2019budget in ordertoallowthe parties sufficient timefornegotiation and execution of an agreement with astartdateofOctober1,2018,ensuringan uninterrupted continuation ofservices. The City previously executed Amendment No. 7, which added a 2.5% cost of living increase in the amount of \$2,711, and was approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2017-2018. Amendment No. 6 exercised a 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2017 for \$108,438. Amendment No. 5 added a 2.3% cost of living increase in the amount of \$2,438, which was approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Amendment No. 4 exercised a 12-month extension option beginning September 30, 2016 for \$106,000. Amendment No. 3 added a 6% cost of living increase in the amount of \$6,000, which was approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2015-2016. Amendment No. 2 exercised a 24-month extension option beginning September 30, 2014 for \$200,000. Amendment No. 1 was a no-cost amendment to add client eligibility requirements to the agreement. The original 24-month agreement was approved by Council for \$200,000 beginning September 27, 2012.

On March 25, 2010, Council passed Resolution No. 20100325-053 directing the City Manager to give priority tofunding PSH, and to develop a comprehensive strategy for the construction and operation of 350 permanentsupportive housing units over the next four years.

On October 2, 2014, Council passed Resolution No. 20141002-043 directing the City Manager to set a community target of 400 additional PSH units. The goals included, reaching the community target using community-wide efforts within four years, and to adopt the recommended August 2014 PSH Evaluation report updates to the PSH strategy.
