Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide maintenance and support for the airport security access control system and video management system for Aviation (Airport). The contractor will provide system monitoring, database maintenance, software licenses, training, on-site support, and related repair parts. The access control system ensures that only appropriate personnel have access to certain areas while the video management system is used to monitor inside the terminal and the perimeter. This contract will ensure that the Airport has a stable, reliable system that is in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations.

This new contract is replacing the current contract expiring in April 2019. The new contract will cover additional requirements such as on-site support and additional funds needed to support airport future expansion projects. The recommended contractor is the current provider for these services.

An evaluation team with expertise in this area evaluated the offers and scored Convergint Technologies, LLC as the best to provide these services based on prior experience and references, concepts and solutions, service-disable veterans business enterprise preference, local business presence, and price.

A delay in approving or failure to approve this contract will prevent the Airport from being compliance with FAA and TSA requirements for an active security system.
