

27 **WHEREAS**, committed volunteers from the Code Advisory Group,
28 Planning Commission, Zoning and Platting Commission, other City Commissions,
29 and City of Austin residents have dedicated countless hours to the CodeNEXT
30 process leading to informative and valuable work, insight, and input; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the process of a comprehensive rewrite of a Land
32 Development Code is necessarily complicated and requires consistent executive
33 leadership from staff, a stable political framework, and reliable analytical data;

34 **NOW THEREFORE,**

35 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

36 The Council finds that due to a combination of significant disruptions to the
37 process, CodeNEXT is no longer a suitable mechanism to achieve its stated goals
38 or address the critical challenges currently facing our City.

39 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

40 The City Manager is directed to develop and propose a new process leading
41 to a Land Development Code that achieves the stated goals of the City as outlined
42 in the *Imagine Austin Comprehensive Plan*, the *Strategic Housing Blueprint*, and
43 the *Austin Strategic Direction 2023 Plan*.
