

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the Firefighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Civil Service Commission (the Commission) has been established to ensure general compliance with applicable provisions of Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code, the local Civil Service Rules established by the Commission, and any current agreements between the City of Austin and associations representing firefighters, police officers, and emergency medical services personnel.

WHEREAS, the Commission may take action on matters related to promotion, appeals of promotional exams, suspension and termination as well as other matters regarding firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services personnel in accordance with the above-mentioned statutes, rules and agreements; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 143.006 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that the City Manager will appoint three Commissioners for staggered terms, and that the appointment must be confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, if a vacancy occurs, the City Manager shall appoint a person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Andrew Harris resigned from the Firefighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Civil Service Commission on July 2, 2018. His unexpired term ends on December 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has appointed _____ to fill the vacancy on the Commission created by Commissioner Harris's resignation.
