## Additional Backup Information:

This agreement is between the City of Austin Department of Aviation (Aviation) and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) for Aviation's reimbursement of CBP for costs related to providing the necessary data, technology, and electrical equipment and installation required for the performance of the Federal Inspections Services (FIS) facility at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (Airport). The equipment is needed to support the new international gates

that are currently being constructed at the Airport as part of the terminal 9 gate expansion project.

CBP information is Sensitive Security Information under federal law; therefore, CBP is responsible for ordering and installing the required data, technology, and electrical equipment and connecting this equipment from the Airport's FIS to the CBP National Data Center.
