20 **WHEREAS**, Austin’s ‘silver tsunami’ poses unique challenges and opportunities
21 across the City portfolio to meet the needs of the rising number of elderly, and the LBJ
22 School proposal addresses a number of these critical issues; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the City has not had a thorough consideration of the best use of the
24 City-owned RBJ Health Center; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

25 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

26 The City Council directs the City Manager to:

- 27 • review the analysis completed to date and assess the need for an adult day
28 center on City-owned facilities, such as at the RBJ Public Health Center as
29 proposed by the LBJ school team. This review should be done in
30 conjunction with the LBJ school team, the Commission on Seniors, and
31 other experts on senior services, such as the Dell Medical School, as
32 appropriate;
- 33 • determine the feasibility of developing City-owned facilities for such
34 purposes, including the RBJ Public Health Center;
- 35 • recommend a process for developing an adult day center at the City-owned
36 RBJ Public Health Center, or other potential City-owned facilities, as
37 determined by the assessments described in this resolution; and
- 38 • report back to City Council with recommendations no later than March 1,
39 2019.
