



21           **WHEREAS**, City Council recognizes a need for training and licensing for  
22 individuals and entities who provide housing and domestic care services to clients with  
23 unique health needs; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

24 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

25           The City Council directs the City Manager to explore opportunities and options to  
26 improve the standard of care offered by providers of housing and domestic care services to  
27 clients with physical and mental health-related issues who do not receive state-regulated  
28 services. The City Council encourages the City Manager to explore the viability of  
29 licensing individuals (and entities) who provide these services, who are not subject to state  
30 regulation and an incentive program for those providers who improve the quality of life for  
31 their clients.

32 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

33           The City Council directs the City Manager to return with recommendations by April  
34 25, 2019.
