On behalf of the Office of Sustainability, the Austin Fire Department is accepting a \$25,000 Innovation Fund grant to create a prototype of a web-based real-time smoke-map. The grant comes from the Urban Sustainability Directors Network (USDN) - a project of Global Philanthropy Partnership (GPP) - to provide jurisdictions with new tools to communicate about wildfire smoke events. The Office of Design & Delivery, which specializes in user-centered technology design, will convene community partners to develop the key design criteria for maps of East Austin neighborhoods where there are significantly higher levels of asthma and Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) rates.
