

**ORDINANCE NO. 20190411-022**

**AN ORDINANCE PROCLAIMING APRIL 23, 2019 AND SEPTEMBER 17, 2019  
AS BARTON SPRINGS UNIVERSITY DAY AND WAIVING CERTAIN FEES.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1. FINDINGS.**

- (A) Barton Springs University Day was established as a stand-alone event in 2015 as a day of learning during which Barton Springs is open to the general public, with an emphasis on enabling Austin-area high school and college students to learn about the science, policy challenges, and historic and cultural aspects of Barton Springs, Edwards Aquifer, and the waters of Central Texas.
- (B) The City Council has supported Barton Springs University Day each year by proclaiming a specific day in September for the event and by waiving certain fees.
- (C) For 2018, the City Council proclaimed September 25, 2018 as Barton Springs University Day. Unfortunately, the event was cancelled because of the September 2019 flooding event experienced by the City.
- (D) The City Council desires to provide for a substitute event day for the cancelled 2018 event and to proclaim Barton Springs University Day for 2019.

**PART 2.** City Council proclaims April 23, 2019 as Barton Springs University Day as the substitute event day for the 2018 cancelled event. City Council proclaims September 17, 2019, as Barton Springs University Day for 2019 (with a rain date scheduled for September 24, 2019.)

**PART 3.** City Council waives the following admission fees for the April 23, 2019 and September 17, 2019 events (with a rain date scheduled for September 24, 2019.)




