If approved, the Austin Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) would be authorized to execute loan agreement documents, as appropriate, with the non-profit The College Houses, or an affiliated entity, to assist with rehabilitation a portion of the 80-unit cooperative, located 707 West 21st Street. The proposed activity will be located in Council District 9.

Project Proposal

The 21st Street Co-op was built in 1974 and is in need of immediate rehabilitation of the connecting exterior walkways, stairways, and balconies, to be replaced with stronger and more durable materials. The 100-bed facility would reserve 20 units for households earning at or below 30% of Median Family Income (MFI), and 60 units for households earning at or below 40% MFI. All units would have a 40-year affordability period. The proposed source of funding for this project would be the University Neighborhood Overlay (UNO) Trust Fund.
