ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This action will appropriate \$200,000 from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Recreational Trails Grant program to the City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department's Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Capital Budget. The Parks and Recreation Department will match the grant with \$50,000 from the 2012 General Obligation Bond Program, which is available in the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Capital Budget. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Parks and Recreation Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
