Section 802.1012 of the Texas Government Code requires that all public retirement systems with assets greater than \$100 million have its actuarial valuations, studies and reports audited by an independent actuary every five years. State law further states that the governing body shall maintain a copy of the final audit report at its main office for public inspection.
