- the Code of Federal Regulations; and 12
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 13 373.006(1), (2), and (3), the City Council: 14
- 1. identifies in its Consolidated Plan for Fiscal Years 2019-2024 areas of 15 the municipality in which predominantly low-and moderate-income persons reside, 16 or that are blighted or slum areas; and 17
 - 2. establishes in its Consolidated Plan for Fiscal Years 2019-2024 community development areas in which community development activities, building rehabilitation, or the acquisition of privately-owned buildings or land are proposed; and
 - 3. provides opportunities for residents to provide public comment on proposed Consolidated and Annual Action Plans as set forth in the City's Citizen Participation Plan (CPP), which City Council adopted by Resolution No. 960328-31 on March 28, 1996, amended by Resolution No. 000113-29 on January 13, 2000, amended by Resolution No. 040129-8 on January 29, 2004, amended by

- 27 Resolution No. 20111215-089 on December 15, 2011, and amended by Council approval on November 9, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, on February 7, 2019 and May 9, 2019, the City Council conducted two public hearings to obtain public input for the development of the proposed Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.066(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of Code of Federal Regulations; and
 - WHEREAS, on January 8, 2019 and February 12, 2019, the Community Development Commission conducted public hearings to obtain public input for the development of the proposed Consolidated Plan and annual Action Plan, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations; and
 - WHEREAS, on May 14, 2019, the Community Development Commission conducted a public hearing to obtain public comment on the proposed Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations; and
 - **WHEREAS**, beginning April 16, 2019, the City Manager made the proposed Consolidated Plan and annual Action Plan available for a 30-day public comment period; and
 - **WHEREAS**, on May 14, 2019, the Community Development Commission made its final recommendation on the proposed Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan; **NOW**, **THEREFORE**,
