Council Committee, Boards and Commission Action:

Additional Backup Information:

In FY 2019-20 the City expects to receive \$13,133,352 through four U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) entitlement grants, including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG). In order to receive these HUD grants, the City must submit a Five-year Consolidated Plan for Fiscal Years 2019-2024 and an Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 that describes community needs, resources, priorities and proposed activities with regard to housing, community development, economic development and public services.

This action complies with the City's Citizen Participation Plan (CPP), which sets forth the City's policies and

procedures for citizen participation in the development of each Five-year Consolidated plan and Annual action plan. The steps for public participation include five public hearings: one before the Austin City Council, two before the Community Development Commission (CDC), and two before organizations working with low-and moderate-income populations. The process is also includes a 30-day public comment period on the draft Five-year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan.

The FY 2020-24 draft Five-Year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan was made available at ten community centers and at http://austintexas.gov/five for public comment beginning on April 16, 2019. The Five-year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan are due to HUD on August 15, 2019.
