Additional Backup Information:

The requested contract increase is to provide maintenance and support for Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) hardware that was not included in the initial contract awarded on November 1, 2018. The initial contract amount was based on the department's estimation at that time and previous spend. This HPE equipment supports the very substantial Advanced Distribution Management System (ADMS) environments at the System Control Center and Back up Control Center. The ADMS is a critical utility system running automatic functions that improve distribution system reliability and efficiency by managing outages and field crew assignments. Expansion of the support services will allow Austin Energy to continue to enhance customer service and reliability while optimizing operating costs.

The proposed amendment is necessary to expand hardware support and maintenance. A delay in approving or a failure to approve this amendment, may result in hardware failures which could cause the ADMS system performance to become degraded and impact situational awareness for operators and the safety of field crews.
