WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize application for and acceptance of \$452,219 in grant funding from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority to continue the Austin Police Department project entitled the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for and acceptance of grant funds in the amount of \$452,219 from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority to continue the Austin Police Department project entitled the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has committed to provide any necessary matching funds for this grant through approval of the Austin Police Department budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to, alter, or terminate this grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Austin Police Department Financial Manager as the financial officer who will be responsible for these grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Austin Police Department Property Crimes Lieutenant as the project director who will continue and manage the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of these Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority grant funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority in full; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council approves the application for and acceptance of grant funding in the amount \$452,219 from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority to continue the Austin Police Department project entitled the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project.
