Additional Backup Information:

Every year, the City of Austin, along with Travis County and the Austin Independent School District, offers a partial exemption from ad valorem taxes to owners of historic landmarks who maintain their property and have passed an annual inspection of their property, in accordance with City Code. The list attached to this RCA known as Exhibit A consists of those properties which have passed the annual inspection and to direct the City Manager to include the annual historic landmark exemptions in the upcoming city budget deliberations. The Travis Central Appraisal District has already calculated the amount of the proposed exemptions, and that information has been forwarded by them to the city budget office.
