Authorize negotiation and execution of a cooperative contract with Stop Stick, Ltd., for the purchase of tire deflation devices and accessories, in an amount not to exceed \$72,368.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract is for the purchase of nine-foot Stop Stick tire deflation devices, rack kits, and accessories that will equip each Austin Police Department (APD) patrol unit with a tire deflation device. Stop Stick is the only product designed for tire deflation that offers a collapsible plastic housing which provides officer safety from the spikes during deployment. These devices are also designed for the deploying officer to utilize an 80-foot cord that protects the officer by keeping a safe distance from the road. Stop Stick deploys multi-directional spikes to ensure correct deployment on any side. Furthermore, this product deploys in less than 10 seconds, weighs less than four pounds, and is equipped with a trunk lid-mounting rack that allows for fast and easy access.

The General Services Administration Federal Supply Schedule establishes competitively bid contracts that can be utilized government agencies through a cooperative agreement. Cooperative agreements save taxpayer dollars by leveraging volume-buying power to drive down costs on hundreds of contracts through a streamlined
