### **Council Committee, Boards and Commission Action:**

This ordinance is proposed for emergency passage by Council without Commission action to provide an effective date prior to the September 1, 2019, effective date of the legislation.

### **Additional Backup Information:**

The 86<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature passed House Bill 3167, which modified the requirements applicable to county and municipal approval of land development applications regulated by section 212 of Local Government Code (LGC). HB 3167 created specific requirements for the processing, approval, and disapproval of applications that necessitate amendments to both Titles 25 and 30 of the City of Austin Land Development Code to remain in compliance with state law. Staff is preparing an ordinance for Council consideration on the August 22<sup>nd</sup> agenda that will adopt the modifications to Titles 25 and 30 of the LGC. The proposed amendments to Title 30 are being scheduled for consideration by the Travis County Commissioners Court on the August 27<sup>th</sup> agenda providing the required approval by both public bodies as outlined in the City County 1445 agreement. This ordinance is proposed for emergency passage by Council without Commission action to provide an effective date prior to September 1, 2019.
