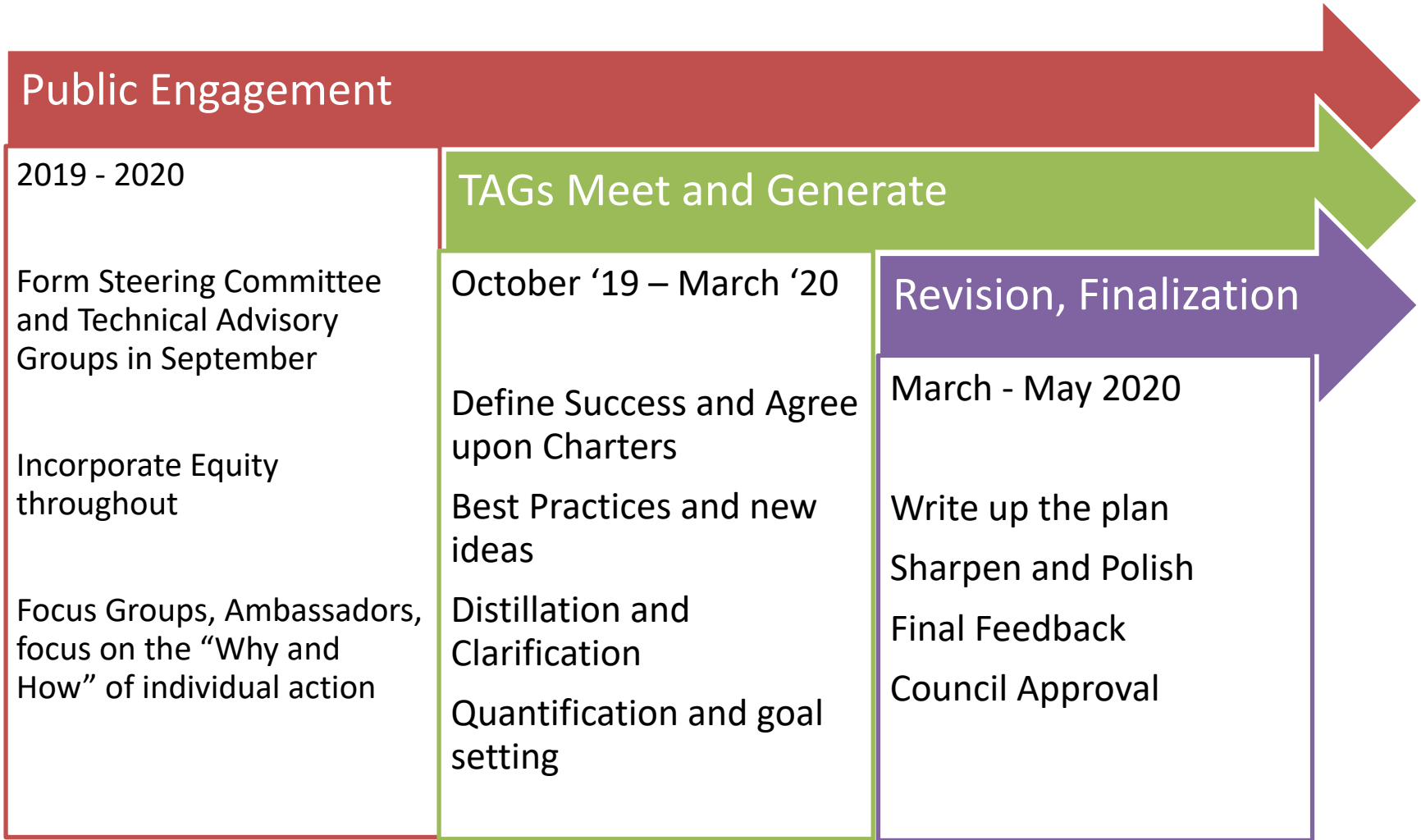

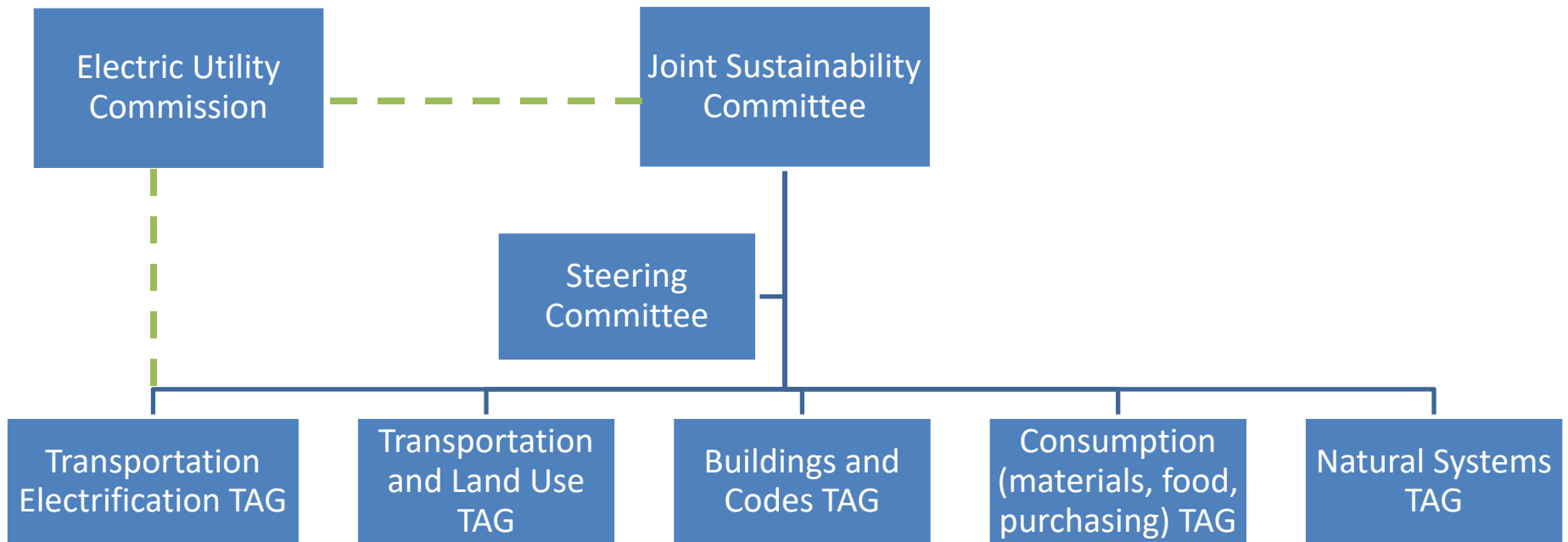
Making Equity a Priority
